Individual Volunteer

With the changes of society and the increasing demand of the people, voluntary services have also received much attention from all walks of life, and have developed into an indispensable part to effectively promote public affairs. Handson Shanghai is committed to building a flexible and effective volunteer service platform, paying more attention to volunteer experience and “heart” service.

Volunteers are willing to take part in volunteering, and the volunteers in Shanghai have no allowances or salary. Volunteers of Handson Shanghai are mainly registered through the online platform, and the items presented on the official website calendar are clear at a glance. As long as the volunteers register, get the Shanghai ID in hand, they can flexibly and freely choose the items that suit their time and interests, and self-register. And the system’s reply letter will be sent to the registration emails of the volunteers immediately, including the time of the event, the meeting place, the transportation route, the contact information and precautions of the volunteer leader on the day, and the volunteer leader will meet the day before the event. Contacting each registered volunteer one by one can almost allow volunteers to participate in our volunteer activities without any worries.

Individually participated projects and activities include: care for sick children, care for the elderly, care for mentally handicapped groups, environmental protection, education project. Behind this, the most thankful are the volunteer leaders. There are tens of thousands of registered volunteers in Shanghai. Weekly regular volunteer activities are led by one or two volunteer leaders. They must not only be familiar with the volunteer service of the day, but also communicate these to the volunteers. At the end of the summary and sharing, at the same time need a certain on-the-spot adaptability.

Volunteer leaders are the soul of Handson Shanghai. They are active in the front line of volunteer service, making volunteer services more efficient and pragmatic, guaranteeing the quality of volunteer services, and the source of the power of holding hands in Shanghai.

College students are full of vitality and are an important part of young volunteers. College student volunteers can bring vitality and joy to the recipient groups. In 2018, we have cooperated with 32 student associations in 22 colleges and 7 middle schools to implement and create a series of short-term and long-term volunteer service projects. 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Educational Program for Migrant Children

As the pace of urban development accelerated, a large number of migrant workers from Shanghai joined the construction tide of Shanghai. At the same time, the children of migrant workers from Shanghai also followed their parents and entered Shanghai to study, work and live. Currently, there are more than 400,000 migrant children of school age in Shanghai. As the second generation of “immigrants” entering Shanghai and the future “new Shanghainese”, they can receive compulsory education in specialized migrant children’s schools here. Gradually enter public schools and study and live with local students. In recent years, government support and social attention have greatly improved the school facilities and teachers of migrant children. In order to give these children more opportunities to explore and develop their qualities, abilities, and specialties, Handson Shanghai has been recruiting and organizing educational volunteers to come to migrant children’s schools since 2008 to improve the infrastructure and teaching environment for the school. It has provided a wealth of extracurricular activities for children.

Forms include:

Hardware improvement and maintenance: book box production, wall painting, campus green construction, donation of school supplies, etc.

Course teaching:

English interest courses, science interest courses, sex education courses, moral education courses, comprehensive science courses, art courses such as painting and handicraft etc.

Interest clubs:

basketball club, reading club, football club, etc.

Summer Charity Summer Camp:

Charity summer camp activities that last for about one month each summer, including indoor interest courses, outdoor visits, charity carnival activities, etc.

Educational Program for Migrant Children

Highlights

The highlight is the identification club composed of 7 volunteers from Fudan University, East China University of Political Science and Law, and Jiaotong University. It is a lecture on the lack of knowledge of sexual education among students in domestic schools. They bring the “adolescent lecture hall” into elementary school classrooms, textbook-style explanations were transformed with funny and simple language, making the topic of sexual knowledge difficult to be heard in China easily and interestingly, which was warmly welcomed by students. In the classroom, the public account of the identity club insists on monthly tweets, actively organizes online discussions and offline activities, summarizes class experience, and actively discusses in groups. At present, the team of the recognition society is constantly expanding, with like-minded people from different schools actively paying attention and participating actively. We look forward to more volunteers joining this team in the future to expand the influence of the project, support the project to enter more schools, and benefit more students.



Sick Child Care Project — Children's Hospital

Tens of thousands of parents bring their children from all over the country to the doctor's office in Shanghai every day. Not only are parents anxious, but the sick children are also very uncomfortable, and it feels long and difficult.

College student volunteer teams, individual volunteers and corporate volunteer teams actively participate in the Handson Shanghai Patient Care Project to bring joy and

smile to sick children and parents. Volunteers interact closely with children, make infants and toddlers laugh, accompany older children to play games, draw pictures, tell stories, talk and chat with parents, bring happy and relaxed time, and ease children's dullness and parental pressure. Not only on weekdays, volunteers use cartoon characters to enter the hospital during the festival, so that the sick children can feel the festive atmosphere and happiness.

Highlight Activities

Children's Medical Center Parent Group for Children with Congenital Heart Disease

When the sick child is being treated in the hospital, their parents are also experiencing physical, mental, and economic pressure caused by the disease of the sick child. The CICU manual group project for parents of sick children co-created with Handson Shanghai was implemented and implemented by the Chenxi Society of Shanghai Jiao Tong University School of Medicine in the second half of 2018. It is hoped that the project will bring spiritual comfort and comfort to parents.

Music Project

When the sick child is waiting in the hospital, there is always a long time to wait. There is a music corner in this waiting hall. In addition to the piano, there are various instruments brought by volunteers to bring parents and sick children waiting. Go to the wonderful music and soothe their helpless time.

Bed time story

The bedtime story is the one with the highest registration rate for volunteers in Shanghai. In addition to volunteers telling stories to children, children can often tell a story to volunteers, and spending time with each other is the best thing to give each other.



Sick Child Care Project — Cerebral Palsy Rehabilitation Center

With such a group of children, they are born with mental or physical impairments. In Shanghai, there are many rehabilitation institutions for children with intellectual or physical disabilities, providing them with a warm living environment, striving to explore the children's potential and restore normal mobility. Handson Shanghai regularly recruits training volunteers to come to the rehabilitation institution, assists the rehabilitation teacher through games and companionship, teaches children simple cognitive knowledge, and designs game lessons for children with dysfunction, which aims to bring warmth and care to children with cerebral palsy.



Mentally Handicapped Group Project — Mental Retardation



There is a special group in Shanghai, including people with intellectual disabilities in Sunshine Homes in various districts, and homeless people in rescue stations. Since 2005, holding hands with individual and corporate volunteer teams in Shanghai, the Student Volunteer Society has begun to pay attention to people with mental disabilities and participate in the activities of the Sunshine House and the rescue station. At the Sunshine House in various districts of Shanghai, volunteers accompany the Sunshine House students in each district to do simple handicrafts, festival-themed activities, English lessons, baking lessons, outdoor activities, and accompany them to spend a pleasant afternoon together.

Mentally Handicapped Group Project — Autism Care

Autistic children are living in their own universe, their eyes are clear, but their eyes dodge; they can talk but they are silent. Behind it, is the cruel and sad reality of autism patients. Art intervention in the field of autism education is a positive way to intervene in autistic patients, and strive to improve their ability to live and promote social integration. Hand in hand with a number of social groups and organizations in Shanghai to launch a series of autism art projects, such as ukulele, graffiti, football, basketball, yoga, etc. Use the stars' hobbies as a bridge to help them build interaction with others through activities and gradually improve their ability to communicate with others.

Forms include:

Painting / Ukulele Orchestra / African Drum Orchestra / Family Yoga / Basketball Club / Football Club

In this project you can contribute

Professional skills: painting / ceramics, or singing and dancing, or sports

Materials: painting materials or purchase of Xing'er paintings, support children's exhibitions, concerts, etc.



Elderly Care Program

Today, Shanghai's nursing homes have three percent of the city's elderly. This kind of elderly has two types of needs: basic survival needs, such as accommodation, diet, physical exercise, etc.; personal spiritual needs, including humanistic care, psychological companionship, and integration with the community. Elderly care institutions have provided adequate services for basic survival needs, but there is still much room for improvement in spiritual needs, and the limitations of life in nursing homes make the elderly feel socially helpless and lacking in value. Taking into account these needs of the elderly, hand in hand with Shanghai and a number of nursing homes to carry out long-term volunteer service projects, provide diversified volunteer positions, and let more people enter this group.

Volunteer forms include:

Chatting / Reading Newspaper / Walking / Doing Games / Doing Crafts / Performance / Write down the old man's story in words and photos / Organize theme events-birthday party, holiday theme party, etc.

Highlight activities:

Hearing Impaired Smartphone Course for the Elderly
With the development of technology, the function of smart



phones is reflected in all aspects of life. The convenience brought by technology to young people is not a problem for the elderly. At present, there are no smart phones for the hearing impaired. . In order to enable this group to better enjoy the benefits of smartphones, Shanghai United Sunshine House is held in hand, and the volunteer department of the Shanghai University of Finance and Economics Financial Association is responsible for project development and implementation, tailored for the elderly with hearing impairment. Their smartphone courses.

Environmental Protection Project — Beach Cleanup

While urban construction is developing rapidly, its offshore resources have a tendency to degrade, and the contradictions between population, resources and the environment have become increasingly prominent. Protecting the marine environment on which we depend has become a responsibility we cannot ignore. The beach clean-up activities in Shanghai, through mobilizing and encouraging citizens to actively participate in the beach clean-up activities, enable participants to feel the relationship between people, the sea and nature in the process of beach participation in cleaning activities.

At the same time, shoreline garbage data collected during clean beach activities will be used to support scientific research and monitoring of shoreline garbage nationwide. Handson Shanghai has organized a clean-up project of Fengxian Bihai Jinsha Beach and Nanhuizui Beach from 2012 in which student associations, enterprises and individuals participated in the project. As of 2018, a total of 6,100 volunteers have participated in this project, totaling 40310 kilograms of garbage and 267 kilometers of coastline.



Environmental Protection Project — River Watching



Social development is changing with each passing day, but the environmental situation is getting worse. Behind the glamorous and beautiful Shanghai, there are also water pollution problems. Monitoring by relevant agencies shows that there are still many black and stinky waters in Shanghai who are stubbornly resisting! In order to build a green home, in conjunction with the Shanghai United River Watcher Center in 2018, we will regularly carry out monitoring projects on black and stinky rivers in Shanghai and monitor 10 key black and odorous water bodies. By investigating the black and odorous water body, organizing public comment on the effect after the treatment, and forming a research report; establishing a benign multi-party dialogue mechanism between the government, enterprises, social organizations, and the public to promote the treatment of the black and odorous water body.

Environmental Protection Project — Environmental Recycling



This year, we work with TerraCycle China office and Terry Environmental Protection to promote a green lifestyle and reduce the environmental pressure caused by waste.

Terui Environmental Protection is an international innovative social enterprise dedicated to waste disposal, providing individuals, enterprises and governments with a new “collection-treatment-promotion” new waste recycling solution.

Environmental Protection Project — Good Deeds Day



This is a global charity action. Since its launch in 2007, millions of people from 93 countries have participated in this charity event. We believe that every individual has the ability to contribute his love to others and the positive change of society. In 2018, Good Deeds Shanghai was held on April 15. On this day, we teamed up with Shanghai University student teams to go to Nanhuizui and Fengxian Beach for beach cleaning activities, and within a week before and after the 15th, environmental protection theme advocacy and waste recycling activities (such as old clothes) will also be carried out on campuses , waste batteries, expired drugs, old books, etc.), hoping to pass the green concept to more small partners.

Music and Art Festival Project

The music festival has become more and more important in the development of the city. It is an important part of the cultural industry. At the same time, it reflects the city's international image, degree of civilization, cross-cultural communication and international cooperation capabilities. From the perspective of sustainable development, the festival has the characteristics of public identity, resource integration, international communication, cultural characteristics, long-term periodic continuous effects, and various social functions. It is not only a city's public cultural service to meet its own cultural life needs, but also a city's distinctive brand and comprehensive competitiveness. Upgrading the path, while allowing the next generation of children to grow up in a strong cultural atmosphere, can help people living in this city to re-understand their own culture, increase the local people's sense of cultural identity, cultural belonging and cohesion. At the same time, this is a service project loved by volunteers.



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Make a Difference Day

It has been 8 years since the “Make A Difference Day (MADD) | Shanghai Customs Love Day” event held in Shanghai. As of last year, we had collected 4,000 volunteers, and a total of 50 companies participated in it, with more than 250 volunteer service sites. Thanks to all the enthusiastic and active volunteer Peter Pans for their company and support, so that we can continue to move forward and strive to become a more influential voluntary service support platform. During the “Shanghai Customs Love Day” project from November 12th to 25th, 2018, we held hands with Shanghai to carry out cooperative annual volunteer service actions with a number of public welfare partners and community partners. Focusing on the “green earth” environmental protection theme, we mobilize people from all walks of life to understand, pay attention to, and act with us, and promise to start from ourselves in daily life and positively affect others. Through the interaction at the event site, many citizens and students infected by the volunteer action also actively asked how to become volunteers to participate in similar activities. We believe that only when you stop complaining and start taking action will it be possible to see changes in the future.

With the support of KLA China, 2018 MADD achieved the following results:

- 30 events in 14 days covering 8 communities in 2 cities
- Indirectly affects 9,728 residents and young people
- 13 universities responded, 3 companies sponsored cooperation
- 1 environmental protection social enterprise PRO BONO support
- A total of 1,586 volunteers participated in offline volunteer operations
- Contributed 6,375 volunteer hours
- Recycling of 204 kg of recyclable waste
- Clean up and pick up 1.58 tons of marine debris
